I would like now to give you my report that you can use for your Newsletter to your mission- & prayer partner of "Ein Herz für Nationen e.V. :

"I personally and my church are very thankful to evangelist Max Gloor for coming and organizing the " Youth training camp 2004 here in our city of Kraljevo. We want to thank all of "Ein Herz für Nationen e. V. and their partners, who supported this project in prayer and in finances. May the Lord bless and reward all of you abundantly.

There were 70 participants at the Youth camp from 10 - 16 May 2004 , and the main topic was evangelism in theory and in practice. The big significance of this training seminar was that the teaching that brother Max Gloor did was very practical and applicable, and young people were able to apply it during the week.

Before we had any lessons on evangelism we organized on Tuesday prayer marches in many different areas of Kraljevo destroying the strongholds and binding evil spirits. Prayer is key to revival.

Friday night we planned to be the grand finale with evangelistic outreach in the hotel's hall, so on that day we sent young people to different areas of Kraljevo to give people invitation for the evening concert of Gypsy Christian music. We prayed and God answered our prayers. There were 250 present at the concert and most of them heard the Gospel for the first time that evening. Brother Max Gloor preached excellent Gospel message that was short and sharp, and while he was preaching we felt anointing of God in the hall. When he gave opportunity for people to accept Christ my estimate is that over 40 people responded, maybe even more. Praise the Lord! After that he prayed for the sick people and I heard that some of them were healed and stopped using medication.

The impact of this Youth camp and evangelistic outreach on Friday on participants and city of Kraljevo is so significant and will definitely bring the lasting fruit. It gave our local church lot of new contacts to work with and disciple. I can honestly say that Kraljevo will not be the same after this.
